

1. Where & How to Enter

- a. Entrants may enter by submitting your photo(s) electronically at kcphotos@kitikmeotcorp.com. Submissions must be high resolution digital photos (300 DPI or 8 MP). You must be the owner of the submission(s) and you must have obtained all the consents from all identifiable third parties in the submission (and their parent/legal guardian if they are under the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence) to use their image.
- b. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older and a resident of the Kitikmeot Region to participate in this contest. Board of Directors (BoD) along with Employees of Kitikmeot Corporation and their immediate families with whom they reside, are not eligible to win.
- c. Photos must have been taken between January 1, 2023 and December 15, 2023.
- d. Each entry must state the category for which it is to be entered (Inuit Culture, People or Animals & Landscapes).
- e. Each person can submit up to 3 photos per category. 9 photo entries maximum.

2. Entries

- a. By entering the contest, entrants agree that photos submitted become the property of the Kitikmeot Corporation and can be used by the Kitikmeot Corporation for advertising purposes.
- b. The photo must be in its original state and cannot be altered in any way, including but not limited to removing, adding, reversing, or distorting subjects within the frame.
- c. Entries will not be accepted unless submitted via the official contest email. Entries not submitted through the proper email will be deleted.
- d. For greater certainty, Kitikmeot Corporation reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, edit or remove any entry submission, or to request an entrant to modify or edit his or her entry submission, if a complaint is received with respect to the entry submission, or for any other reason.
- e. Participation in the contest requires the collection of your name and community name.
 By entering this contest, you are consenting to the use of your information to announce the winners of the contest.



- f. Photographs that include sculptures, statues, paintings, and other works of art will be accepted as long as they do not constitute copyright infringement or fraud. When photographing the work of others, it must be as an object in its environment and not a full-frame close-up of another person's art.
- g. The photograph, in its entirety, must be a single work of original material taken by the entrant. By entering the contest, entrant represents, acknowledges, and warrants that the submitted photograph is an original work created soley by the entrant, that the photograph does not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other party has any right, title, claim, or interest in the photograph.

3. Prize Categories

- a. The contest will have three (3) prize categories; Inuit Culture People & Animals Landscapes
- b. First, Second and Third place prizes will be awarded for each of the 3 categories. An additional prize for Best Overall Photo will also be awarded. (10 Prizes in total)
- Contest Closing Date— The contest closing date is 11:59 PM MDT,
 December 15, 2023

4. Judging of Photos

- a. The Kitikmeot corporation Board of Directors will choose the winning photos for each category, from this group of photos the BoD will then select the best overall photo to take the grand prize.
- b. The Board of Directors decision on winning photos are final.
