- Provide an enrollment or acceptance letter from an accredited institution (college or university) for full-time studies.
- Include their **most recent transcript** along with the application.
- Submit a completed application form.
- Submit required essay.
- Furnish **two letters of support** (from instructors, teachers, employers, or other relevant sources).
- Share a recent and clear electronic color photograph.
- Present a current resume.

- 2. **Theme**: Collaboration (teamwork) "Piliriqatigiinniq or Ikajuqtigiinniq (working together for a common cause)
  - **Essay prompt**: Describe the importance and value of collaboration in the workplace.
- 3. **Theme**: Collaboration (teamwork) –) Piliriqatigiinniq or Ikajuqtigiinniq (working together for a common cause)
  - **Essay prompt**: Describe an event in which you took a leadership role in a group and what you learned about yourself while working with others.
- 4. **Theme**: Adapting to Change Qanuqtuurniq (being innovative and resourceful) **Essay prompt**: Describe a time where you needed to change, how did you adapt to the change and what difference did it make?
